CS reviews GreenCorridor project

Lucknow: Chief secretary Durga Shankar Mishra reviewed the Lucknow Green Corridor project on Tuesday. He has constituted a three-member committee to review the legal issues pertaining to transfer of two hectare land to UPTRON, a matter which is pending in the Supreme Court.

The CS reviewed the status of other pending land transfers and directed officials to ensure that work on the first phase of the project begins at the earliest and that seed money for it is made available.

The CS also held a meeting of the project monitoring group where he reviewed the Bundelkhand Expressway, Gorakhpur Link Expressway and Ganga Expressway projects.

About the Bundelkhand Expressway, he was informed that 84.70% of the long bridge work, 81.55% of the rail overbridge work and 88.78% of the work on flyovers has been completed. Another 212 underpasses and 131 small bridges have been completed.

Around 32% of the work on the Gorakhpur Link Expressway had been completed by December 31, 2021. The deadline to complete the main carriageway is December 31, 2022. For the Ganga Expressway, 93.03% land has been acquired.
