

Over 6L pleas disposed of by Nivesh Mitra

Lucknow: More than six lakh applications were disposed of by the Nivesh Mitra, the single window portal of the UP infrastructure and industries department according to an official statement issued here on Friday.

The information came up at a review of departmental activities undertaken by the minister Nand Gopal Nandi.

CEO, Invest UP, Neena Sharma said that over 340 services had been integrated by the Nivesh Mitra and six lakh applications were disposed under the arrange-
