

Industry dept met all 100-day targets: Min

Lucknow: As many as 152 reforms for ease of doing business and 45 reforms for ease of living have been implemented in Uttar Pradesh and their cent per cent compliance is expected to be achieved by October 20, 2022.

Listing this as one of his department's key achievement, cabinet minister for industries Nand Gopal Gupta Nandi on Friday said that his department has achieved all the targets set under 100 days goal. "The success of the third ground-breaking ceremony is known to all. And now, the Bundelkhand expressway is ready for launch. The time now is to fix the eyes on goals for six months," said the minister.

He also pointed out that the state would be rolling out the policy framework to boost business activity in the state. While on the one hand, the industrial policy would be launched, policy documents for electrical vehicles, warehousing and logistics policy, aerospace units and employment promotion would follow.
