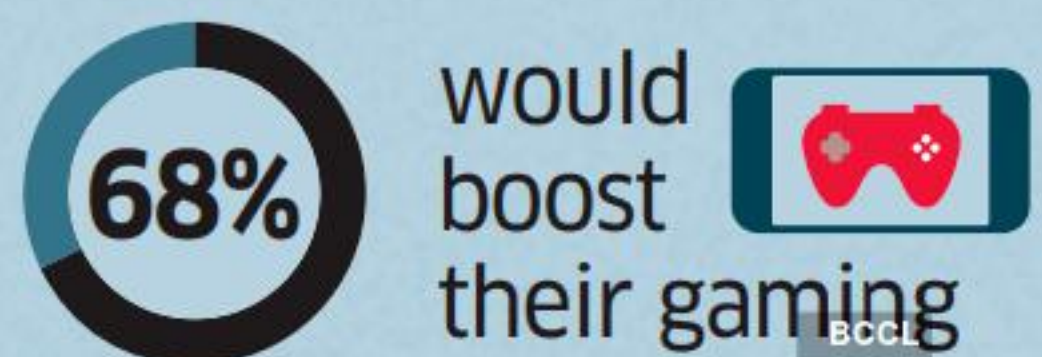
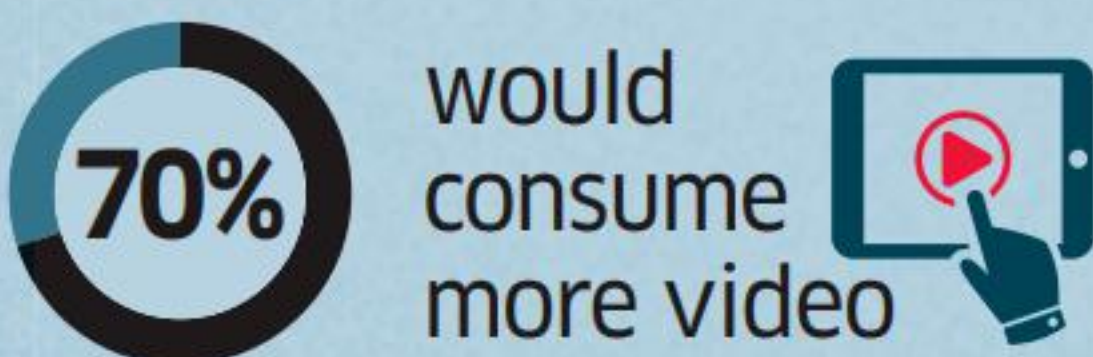

The auction of [5G spectrum](#) ended a week ago and services are expected to be rolled out from later this month

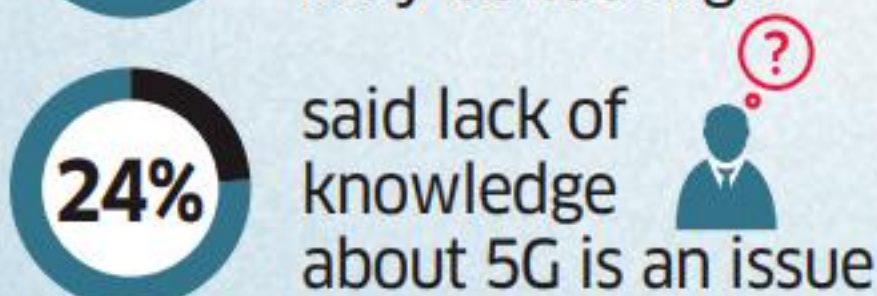
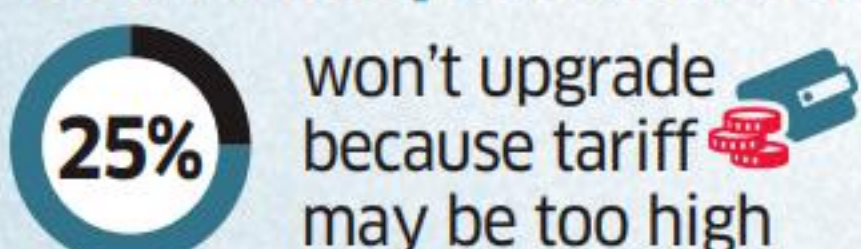
Of those who intend to upgrade to 5G



Usage of 5G



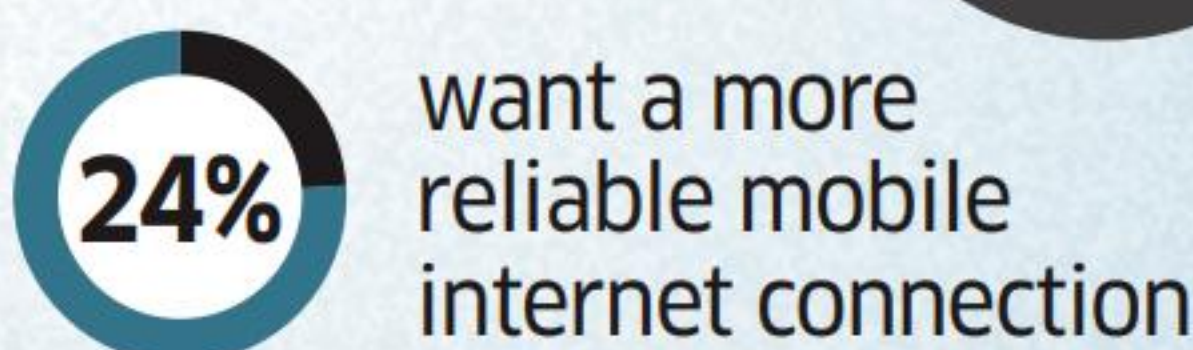
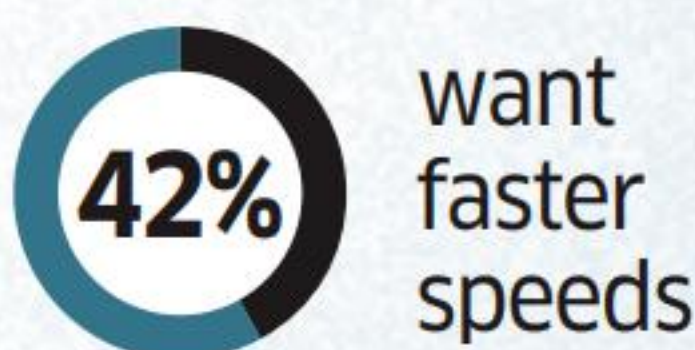
Of the respondents who said they won't upgrade to 5G
