Centre's nod to ₹1000-cr Gati Shakti projects in UP

Lucknow: The Centre has approved 16 projects worth over Rs 1,000 crore under the PM Gati Shakti scheme for UP.

An official said that under the scheme, Rs 897 crore or 17.94% of a corpus of Rs 5,000 crore was earmarked for UP. Development authorities like GIDA, YEIDA, Noida, GNIDA and the MSME department had submitted several proposals under Special Assistance to States for Capital Investment Scheme 2022-23. Out of these, 16 project proposals worth Rs.1,068.79 crore have been approved.

The projects received approval by a screening commit-

tee on annual action plan under chairperson Amrit Lal Meena, special secretary for logistics, department of commerce and industry. Out of the approved projects, five each are for Noida and CM Yogi Adityanath's constituency Gorakhpur, four for the Yamuna Express Industrial Development Authority and three for the Greater Noida Industrial Development Authority.

For the two projects under GNIDA, Rs 129.90 crore has been approved for development of industrial park at Ecotech-8 and Rs 198.60 crore for development of industrial park at Ecotech-10.
