## Businessmen's problems to be solved expeditiously, says Yogi

Lucknow: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanayth on Sunday received a demand from entrepreneurs for establishing an industrial area in place of Nagina spinning mill in Bijnor.

Yogi Adityanath, who was on a tour of Bijnor on Sunday, told entrepreneurs and traders that their problems would be solved expeditiously. The CM also inspected the under-construction Mahatma Vidur Government Medical College and planted saplings at the PWD inspection building. During the inspection the CM was apprised of a medical college that is being constructed in the district at a cost of Rs 281.52 crore in an area of 20.71 acres. A 200-bed hospital is being built in the district hospital, Bijnor,

hospital, it will be of 500 beds.

He said that the state government is cooperating fully in promoting organic farming. "Efforts are being made for the youth of the state to get better education and environment."
