LUCKNOW: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath is likely to visit two countries ahead of the Global Investors' Summit, scheduled to be held in Lucknow in February 2023.

Sources in the CM's office confirmed that the CM is likely to travel to the US where he might visit New York, Chicago and San Francisco, and UK. A senior official privy to the development said that the CM was expected to approve the plan this week after which officers and ministers, who have been designated to carry out international and domestic road shows, would be assigned their locations.

"The road shows are scheduled to start around mid-November. We are expecting delegations to visit several countries and hold at least five domestic road shows. These road shows will be important as they will give UP government a chance to directly interact with potential investors and project the state as an investment friendly hub and talk about its sectoral policies and other developments in the state," the official said, adding that the CM's visits will be even more important as his presence will serve as an assurance that the state is serious about its promises.

A government spokesperson said that delegations led by ministers and senior officials will be deputed to visit various foreign countries to interact with potential investors.

Meanwhile, the CM is already holding meetings in Lucknow with trade organisations and Ambassadors to other countries to pitch UP's investment potential.

The government is looking at investment opportunities of Rs 10,000 crore through the GIS.
