

UP plans infra boost for Global Investor Summit

Lucknow: As part of UP government's plan to attract investment in the state and become a one trillion-dollar economy and to showcase the best in class investment ecosystem during the Global Investor Summit 2023, efforts are being made to upgrade the infrastructure facilities in different areas of the UP State Industrial Development Authority (UPSIDA).

Chief executive officer of the authority, Mayur Maheshwari said that the Atal Industrial Infrastructure Mission will provide the infrastructure facilities currently available in the industrial areas and the necessary infrastructure facilities to be developed in the future.

“Tenders worth Rs 150 crore have been approved for better infrastructure facilities such as roads, drainage system for drainage and upgrading of street lights to the entrepreneurs of all the industrial areas of the authority,” he said.

The list includes building amenities like public toilets, health ATMs, establishment of dormitories for the residence of workers, beautification of industrial areas like gates, parks, green belts, signage, wall paintings on different schemes of the government among other things.

Maheshwari added that tasks like protection of industrial units and industrial units, establishment of police posts and fire stations were also underway.
