Roadshows for GIS 2023 to begin by end of this month

Lucknow: The international and domestic roadshows planned to showcase UP's Global Investors' Summit 2023 will begin by the end of this month. While the two deputy chief ministers and other ministers would start their tours by the end of November, Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath's tour schedule would be announced once his campaigning plan for Gujarat elections is finalised.

"Around 16 ministers will head to various countries to speak to potential investors about UP's investment potential under various sectors. There will be around ten visits. The CM will be heading to London in the UK and at least three cities in the US -New York, San Francisco and Chicago," said an official.

Sources said that the detailed itinerary of ministers would be announced within the next 10 days. Ministers who are not busy with the Gujarat assembly polls will head out first, followed by

others including the CM. "A list of ministers and where they will be travelling to has been drafted but it is yet to get official clearance from the CM. A formal announcement in this regard will be made shortly," the official said. A schedule for domestic road shows is also being readied.

The countries that the ministers are expected to cover include Canada, Germany, Belgium, Sweden, Brazil, Mexico, Argentina, Japan, Singapore, Thailand, South Korea, USA, UK, Australia, Mauritius, South Africa and Israel.

Assembly polls in Gujarat will take place over two phases, on December 1 and December 5 and results will be declared on December 8.

The Global Investors' Summit is scheduled to be held between February 10 and 12. The government is targeting investments of Rs 10 lakh crore during this event, for which the CM has already started holding meetings with representatives of foreign countries.
