UP to invest ₹5Kcrore for power infra

Lucknow: The UP government on Monday claimed that it would work on a "mission mode" to roll out the Centre and state's Revamped Distribution Sector Scheme (RDSS) for improving electricity supply. UP has 60% stake in the scheme.

The state government has asked all power distribution companies to prepare an action plan to provide uninterrupted and secure power supply to consumers, a government spokesperson said.

UP has around 3 crore households with electricity connections. The government has said that building new sub-stations, creating a seamless transmission and distribution system, and activating additional power producing units should be done on a war footing.

According to UP Power Corporation Limited chairman M Devraj, the tendering process has been completed in many districts and the power industry will undergo a significant change as a result of this plan.
