he company, which has presence in USA, Germany, Switzerland and India, uses AI enabled novel hypotheses across the life sciences. They claim that their methods save 50% time that goes in drug discovery. So far, they have earned more than 65 patents and are in the process of filing 125 more patents with the help of high throughput screening capabilities and biophysical characterization.

The delegation also met Business France's Asia and Pacific Area Coordinator, Jean Francois Ambrosio who expressed his intention to further strengthen Indo-French bilateral ties through partnerships in the fields of food processing, agriculture and dairy. The delegation from Uttar Pradesh also met Etienne Poirot Bordin, head of the International Commission of Confederation of SMEs (CPME) and invited them to set up industries under MSMEs in sectors like renewable energy, defence and water transportation.
