

'CM has revised investment target to ₹17L cr'

This will help the government get the maximum investment during the GIS-2023, scheduled in Lucknow from February 10 to 12. Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath has revised the investment target for this event from Rs 10 lakh crore to Rs 17 lakh crore so we need to

target the highest number of potential investors," said a government spokesperson.

UPSIDA was earlier given a target of getting investments of up to Rs 1 lakh crore, a goal the agency has already met.

UPSIDA's chief executive officer Mayur Maheshwari said the authority has a land bank of more than 15,000

acres in its industrial areas. So far, MoUs worth Rs one lakh crore have been signed with various institutions.

The CM has already given directions to hold district wise summits, with two having already been held in Barabanki and Bahraich. Lucknow saw one roadshow on Tuesday while another one will be held on Wednesday.
