

Data centre project completed in record 24 months in Gr Noida, says Hiranandani

Mumbai/Lucknow: Darshan Hiranandani, CEO Hiranandani Group, shared his experience during the Mumbai roadshow on Thursday.

“We recently set up a world-class data centre park in Greater Noida. The idea came in August 2020 during the Covid period and contacted a few states. UP responded within 48 hours. We finalised the location and applied for the project in September. Land was allotted to us in October and in December Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath laid the foundation stone of the project. The necessary

clearance for the project was received in January 2021 and the construction began in March 2021. It was inaugurated on October 31,” said Hiranandani.

He said this was the first time in the history of the group when such a huge project was completed in just 24 months and all the processes were carried out online.

He recalled when his father met the CM and asked for assurances on law and order. “The CM immediately said that we shouldn’t worry, as criminals in UP are either in jail or out of the state,” he said, adding that they have planned to invest Rs 7,000 crore. in phases in UP.
