AHEAD OF THE Global Investors Summit 2023 in Lucknow, the South Indian entrepreneurs have lauded the 'down South' approach of the Uttar Pradesh government and the inclusion of Tamil Nadu businessmen as partners in the state's development.

A large number of South Indian industrialists attended the 'Business to Government' meeting held on Monday at the ITC Grand Chola in Chennai. According to an official statement, the entrepreneurs who attended the meeting were enthusiastic about investment prospects in Uttar Pradesh.
