

Hold roadshows in Chitrakoot div: CM to MP, MLAs

Lucknow: In an interaction with MLAs and MPs from Chitrakoot division to review the status of ongoing projects on Thursday, chief minister Yogi Adityanath directed them to reach out to entrepreneurs and business houses within their areas and encourage people to invest in the state and participate in the upcoming Global Investors' Summit-2023.

Stating that there were immense possibilities for development in Banda, Mahoba, Hamirpur and Chitrakoot districts, the CM added that religious tourism was being encouraged there. "Every district is full of opportunities for industrial develop-

ment. There is sufficient land available. District-wise roadshows must be held in Chitrakoot division as well," the CM said.

The CM said that the state government is in the process of setting up fire stations at all tehsil headquarters in a phased manner. Under this programme, there will be fire stations in every tehsil of Chitrakoot. To ensure smooth functioning of these fire stations, trained personnel would also be stationed there.

Praising the mining-related work taking place in the area, the chief minister further said that the planned efforts over the past five years have resulted in a lot of improvement in the sector.
