Lucknow: A delegation of ministers and senior bureaucrats reached Ahmedabad on Thursday for a three-day interaction with investors ahead of the February 10-12 Global Inves-

tors' Summit.

The main roadshow is scheduled to be held on Friday, where the team will hold various Business to Government (B2G) meetings and a conference where it will talk about UP as a preferred destination for investment.
