Last domestic roadshow in Chandigarh a great success

LUCKNOW: The eighth and the final domestic roadshow held in Chandigarh on Friday ahead of the UP Global Investors' Summit 2023 received business and investment proposals worth over Rs 10,000 crore. As many as 29 MoUs in various sectors were also signed during the roadshow that was led by minister for industrial development Nand Gopal Gupta 'Nandi', minister of state for agriculture Baldev Singh Aulakh and minister of state (independent charge), home guard Dharamveer Prajapati.

"Once these projects touch the ground, more than 20,000 employment opportunities will be created in the state," officials said.

Speaking on the occasion, industrial development minister Nand Gopal Gupta 'Nandi' said: "Uttar Pradesh is the largest consumer state in India.

There is availability of a large, young and skilled work force here. Under

the leadership of Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, the state has emerged as the 'New Uttar Pradesh of New India'."

While Aulakh spoke about the improved connectivity in UP through a network of expressways and airports Prajapati said the infamy about UP's law and order had slipped into history.

Officials said the team was divided into two groups to conduct impactful business to government meetings.
