Lucknow: Reviewing arrangements for the 11 G-20 events that are scheduled to be held in UP from February to August, Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Friday instructed officials to ensure that the state rolls out its best facilities and hospitality for guests.

He said that the event should be used as an opportunity to upgrade the infrastructure of cities and added that the summit would serve as a platform to showcase the state's art, culture, and heritage.
