

# UP gets ₹5L cr proposals at Mum roadshow

Adani, Aditya Birla, Tata Sons, Piramal, Hiranandani, Vedanta Show Interest

**Mumbai/Lucknow:** The first domestic road show ahead of the Global Investors' Summit, led by Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, was a successful start for the state government with investment proposals of more than Rs5 lakh crore being reportedly made at the event.

"In his meeting with the CM, Karan Adani of the Adani Group proposed investments spread over the next five years in the sectors of warehousing and logistics. The group has also proposed cement units at seven locations. Another project discussed was the setting up of medical colleges on PPP mode in Ballia and Shrawasti, and another skill development centre with a capacity of 10,000 in Noida," said a government spokesperson.

Adani and the CM discussed the project of making UP the largest ammunition hub after Brazil and the development of the Lucknow airport. He also discussed the option of Adani Group investing in silos and smart meters manufacturing.

Aditya Birla Group chairperson Kumara Mangalam Birla has reportedly sought the government's assistance in setting up a convention centre in Noida. Appreciating the state's sectoral policies, Birla discussed his plan for investment in food processing, data centers, warehousing and logis-

tics, and solar energy.

Ajay Piramal of Piramal Enterprises said that he would launch a special campaign in Varanasi for a TB-free India and expressed his interest in developing a Pharma Park. JSW Group MD Sajjan Jindal also discussed the possibility of setting up a Pumped Storage Plant in Sonbhadra for power generation, an electronic vehicle manufacturing unit in Kanpur and a paint unit. Jindal also informed the CM that he would like to be involved in the development of a temple and the Naimishdham.

Meanwhile, Darshan Hiranandani, head of the Hiranandani Group, discussed plans for investing in manufacturing semiconductors in collaboration with foreign partners.

The chairperson of Tata Sons, N Chandrasekaran discussed the development of a spiritual circuit in UP

by making Air India's flight service available at all airports in UP, and also development of hotels. He also discussed the company's investment plans in sectors of power, hydrogen, EV, food processing and semiconductor.

Anil Agarwal, head of Vedanta Resources, said that his company was keen on bringing a major research and development project in electronics and EVs to Noida. In addition to this, he said, there is a plan to set up a glass manufacturing unit in Gorakhpur for mobiles and tablets.
