

UP gets 19 investment proposals worth ₹25k-cr at Hyd roadshow

Lucknow/Hyderabad: The state government received 19 proposals of investments worth Rs 25,000 crore in its fifth domestic roadshow, held this time in Hyderabad.

A team led by deputy chief minister Brajesh Pathak interacted with potential investors and invited them to participate in the Global Investors' Summit to be held in Lucknow from February 10 to 12. The proposals, when converted to projects on ground, will generate 32,000 opportunities for employment, a government spokesperson claimed.
