Yogi gives Brand UP script to Bollywood

Lucknow: Inviting suggestions from the film industry on how to develop the upcoming Film City in Greater Noida, chief minister Yogi Adityanath held a meeting with various directors, producers, actors, musicians on Thursday and offered them security, good connectivity, and locales with natural beauty and historical importance in an effort to promote UP as a film production hub.

Yogi met eminent members of the film fraternity in Mumbai and announced that the current film policy would soon be amended to offer 50% subsidy for web series, in line with the subsidy offered to films. The policy will also provide for a 25% subsidy for OTT films and another 25% subsidy from the state government for setting up studios and labs.

In response to a concern raised by actor Suniel Shetty, who requested the government to help address campaigns like #BanBollywood, the CM said: "There were people who accused Lord Ram also and such accusations are made everywhere. We should ignore these and move on with a positive outlook. Films ha-

ve contributed to national integrity and to connect society. The promotion of Hindi by Hindi films is commendable. We have to see the positive aspects."

Yogi said that UP had sent two artists to Parliament, Dinesh Lal Yadav Nirahua from Azamgarh and Ravi Kishan from Gorakhpur.

Saying that at one point people were scared of Azamgarh and one could not even get a hotel room in Mumbai if they said they were from Azamgarh, the CM said that now a person from Mumbai was its MP. Since an artist was its MP, he said, the government had decided to set up a college of music there, in Harihar village.

The Purvanchal Expressway also passes through Azamgarh, he said, which connects Delhi to eastern UP. "From Delhi you can reach Chitrakoot in four hours. Along with security, the UP Government has provided very good connectivity. Chitrakoot and Sonebhadra now have air connectivity. Chitrakoot is known for its natural beauty while Bundelkhand has old, historic forts. The Terai area has many national parks. In earlier years UP had made a huge contribution to arts and now once again we are making important contributions to it. Therefore I try to interact with people from this field," he said.

coming Film City is located 10 minutes from the Jewar Airport and about 45 minutes from the Delhi airport, which would be connected to Greater Noida with Metro and four lane roads. However, UP has no experience in films and therefore, members of the film fraternity need to give their inputs and share their experience to develop a world class project, the CM said.
