

34 proposals of ₹3.9L cr to be implemented in 2 years

These should be given top priority on the implementation list, he said. In addition to these, 34 proposals worth Rs 3.90 lakh crore are ready to be implemented within the next two years. Similarly, 782 proposals worth Rs 4.11 lakh crore have been received from big industrial groups.

The CM said to implement MoUs, it was necessary to maintain regular communication with the investors who should get prompt and satisfactory response to any issue they raise. All MoUs should be reviewed at regular intervals, he said.

“Investment Implementation Units will be set up in all departments for monitoring and implementation of proposals. A secretary level officer should be designated as its head. A nodal officer will be designated for each MoU. Along with this, senior officers of the level of special secretary and above should be given the responsibility of monitoring sector wise, or investment proposal wise. The progress of the work will become proof of their efficiency. Timeline should be fixed for each proposal,” the CM said adding that Udyami Mitra or ‘entrepreneur friends’ will

“Ten Udyami Mitras will be appointed at national level, 25 at the authority level and at least one for every district. For foreign investors, a call centre will be set up by the Industrial Development Department,” Yogi said.

The CM further said “Land is the primary requirement for industries. We will need vast land for such huge investment. We have also received proposals for private industrial parks. Altho-

ugh sufficient land is available in the state, more efforts are needed to make land available according to the interest of the investors and requirement of projects.” Yogi said policies are to be made for sick units and if land of these units is on prime location, it will be put to good use. He said meetings of Udyog Bandhu must be held every three months. In districts, the DMs and SSPs should hold a meeting of district Udyog Bandhu every month.
