

₹5K-cr greenfield project in Ballia to connect with Bihar border

Nitin Gadkari on Monday laid the foundation of national highway projects

worth Rs 6,500 crore, including a Rs 5,320 crore greenfield expressway and a 17-km link road to connect Purvanchal Expressway with the Bihar border, at a function in Chitbadagaon area of Ballia. These two together will reduce the travel time between Patna and Lucknow. He also launched a few road projects.

“The greenfield expressway will not only curtail the travel time for the people of Ballia as well as Bihar for reaching Delhi, Lucknow or Patna, but will also boost economy of this region. East UP is now a frontrunner in development race,” he said.
