Lucknow: The second day of G20 meetings in Lucknow saw discussions on digital public infrastructure (DPI) and cyber security in the digital economy. The meeting was addressed by G20 Sherpa Amitabh Kant, who spoke about India's achievements in DPI.

He said DPI was vital for inclusion, delivery of social services, prevention of monopolization in digital space, and security, privacy and governance. "With effective implementation of DPI, India leapfrogged 40 years of development and progress, in what was expected to be achieved in 47 years. Any country
