Lucknow: Students from Varanasi ruled the UP Global Investors’ Summit Headliner Business Quiz school-level contest, the result of which was declared on Sunday.

Shashwat and Aditya from Sunbeam English School, Lahartara branch, Varanasi, bagged the first prize while Snehit and Vivek from the same school’s Bhagwanpur branch finished second.

Aditya Gaurav of Atulanand Convent School, Koirajpur, ranked third. The winners bagged a cash prize of Rs 50,000 while those on the second and third spots were presented Rs 30,000 and Rs 20,000 respectively.
