

Post GIS, Yogi shifts focus on implementation of MoUs

Lucknow: Two days after the end of Global Investors Summit where the state government received investment proposals of Rs 33.50 lakh crore through over 19,000 MoUs, Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Tuesday held a meeting with senior officials to discuss the modalities of implementation of the projects on ground.

A ground-breaking ceremony to launch “several” projects within the next six months is also in the pipeline.
