
'Road infra to boost textile industry biz'

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Lucknow: Sharing the growth potential of Bundelkhand, Union minister for state (MSME) and Jalaun MP Bhanu Pratap Singh Verma said that the erstwhile backward region is set to leap ahead with better road connectivity and in-

frastructure.
