

With rapid industrialisation in focus, e-ways get good allocations

LUCKNOW: The Yogi Adityanath government has allocated Rs 235 crore for the Jhansi link expressway and the Chitrakoot link expressway in the state's annual budget for the year 2023-24.

The Defence Corridor Project and the Bundelkhand Expressway together received an allocation of Rs 550 crore.

Chief minister Yogi Adityanath's political turf, Gorakhpur, received Rs 200 crore for the development of an industrial corridor on both sides of the Gorakhpur link expressway.

The state government has also approved rapid industrialisation along the Purvanchal and Bundelkhand expressways. Land alongside the two e-ways will be given to industrialists.



The Defence Corridor project and the Bundelkhand Expressway together received an allocation of ₹550 crore.

Also, industrial manufacturing complexes will come up at six places: four on the Purvanchal Expressway and two on the Bundelkhand Expressway.

Apart from this, Rs 25 crore has been earmarked for pharma parks.
