Projects Worth ₹1,450 Cr To Be Inaugurated

Varanasi: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Friday took stock of the integrated packing house and other ready projects, which will be inaugurated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on March 24, in Varanasi.

The Prime Minister will inaugurate and lay the foundation stone of 25 projects worth Rs 1450 crores in Varanasi.

Immediately after his flight landed at the Lal Bahadur Shastri international airport, Yogi left for Karkhiyao industrial area where he inspected the integrated packing house for mango, vegetable and other

agriculture products exports.

Foundation of this packing house project was laid by the PM on July 15, 2021.

Apart from this packing house of Rs 15.78 crore, the PM will also inaugurate the air traffic control tower of LBSI airport, PAC and police barracks and buildings,

small solar power plants at Jal Kal campus of Rs 200 crore.

From Karkhiyao, the CM reached the circuit houses and sought details of the projects which will be inaugurated by the PM.
