

CM to open ₹6K cr projects in Gorakhpur & Kushinagar

Gorakhpur: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath will inaugurate and lay foundation stone for several development projects worth around Rs 6,000 crore in Gorakhpur and Kushinagar districts, on Tuesday and Wednesday.

On Tuesday, the CM will inaugurate and lay the foundation stone of Rs 3,838 crore development projects during a programme at Khorabar in Gorakhpur.

The next day, he will inaugurate and lay foundation stone of projects worth Rs 1,968 in Kushinagar. He will also give a gift of over Rs 11 crore at a programme of Nagar Nigam.
