Yogi govt lists GIS, crackdown on crime as top achievements

LUCKNOW: The Uttar Pradesh government has listed the Global Investors Summit-2023 (UPGIS-2023) that was organised in Lucknow from February 10 to 12, along with zero tolerance for crime and criminals, as its top achievements.

Moveable/immoveable property worth Rs 9022.33 crore was confiscated under provisions of the Gangsters Act in the past six years in the state, it said.

In addition, property worth Rs 2819 crore earned by the mafia and criminals were seized during the same period in Uttar Pradesh, it said.

A booklet listing achievements of Yogi government in the past six years under 30 different heads also mentions the organisation of G20 meeting here last month among its achievements. Chief minister Yogi Adityanath released the booklet along with some posters at a press conference that he addressed to highlight his government's achievements of six years, at Lok Bhavan here on Saturday.

About the GIS-2023, the state government's booklet mentions that 20,682 memorandums of understanding involving investment proposals of Rs 35 lakh crore were signed at the summit and investment will create 1.41 crore job opportunities in the state.

Speaking at the press conference, Yogi said the youngsters of the state did not face a crisis of identity now and would get jobs in accordance with their qualifications anywhere.

He also said Uttar Pradesh, too, was ready now and the double engine government (BJP governments at the Centre and in the state) had worked with dou-

ble or triple speed for the welfare of people.

"We began with Rs 80,000 crore groundbreaking ceremony (during the previous term). We have implemented investment

proposals of Rs 5 lakh crore and lakhs have got jobs (in six years). Everybody is aware of the Global Investors Summit. When the state got investment proposals of Rs 35 lakh crore at the UP GIS- 2023, everybody was surprised," he said.

He also listed sectors in which Uttar Pradesh was leading other states. He said Uttar Pradesh was at second place in the ease of doing business. He said the size of the state budget has doubled in the past six years while UP's per capita income has also doubled.

The unemployment rate is down to 3 to 4% and sugarcane growers have been paid Rs 2.02 lakh crore during the period. He also said U.P. was number one in ethanol production.

The state government was setting up new universities, the chief minister said, adding that now there is a state university in every division.

Uttar Pradesh is also emerging as a new age high-tech manufacturing state, adding that the "biggest" robotic plant is being set up in U.P.
