Gorakhpur: Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Monday directed the administration and police personnel to ensure time-bound redressal of public grievances.

Looking into the complaints of about 400 people during Janata Darshan programme held outside Digvijaynath Smriti Bhawan at Gorakhnath temple, the CM referred the complainants to the officers concerned for prompt disposal. Assuring people of all help from the government, CM Yogi

said, "Everyone's problem will be looked into and resolved."

He also directed officials to ensure provision of benefits of various government's welfare schemes to all eligible beneficiaries. On complaints related to crime, the CM directed police officers to take strict action against the criminals.
