Varanasi: The famous Banarasi paan and Banarasi Langda mango are the two latest products from the city to have got the Geographical Indication (GI) tag. This apart, the 'Adamchini' rice of neighbouring Chandauli district has also joined the GI club recently.

As many as 33 products were granted GI certification on a single day on March 31 by the GI Registry, Chennai. Among them, 10 products belong to UP, including three from Varanasi. As of now, UP has 45 GI
