The Yamuna Expressway in Uttar Pradesh connects Delhi and Agra. The Taj Expressway is another name for the Expressway. It is a controlled-access Expressway with numerous major bridges and seven interchanges. The Yamuna Expressway has reduced the travel time between Delhi and Agra to two to two and a half hours. The Expressway was designed with concerns about car safety and monitoring in mind.

Every 25 kilometres of Expressway has a highway patrol station. The Expressway is being constructed in three stages. The first phase of the project runs from Greater Noida to the Taj International Aviation Hub, which is located near Jewar Village.

Phase II extends from the Taj International Aviation Hub to the halfway point between the Aviation Hubs. The project's third phase runs from the aviation hub to Agra. There are five toll plazas on the Yamuna Expressway.

The construction of the Yamuna Expressway stimulated the rise of real estate in the area. It also increased connectivity to adjacent areas. Infrastructure development encourages additional growth and the installation of amenities in the area.

Noida - Greater Noida Expressway: Extended Expressway in Uttar Pradesh

The Taj Expressway is extended by the Noida Greater Noida Expressway. The Noida-Greater Noida Bundh Expressway would also connect to the FNG (Faridabad-Noida-Ghaziabad) Expressway. It connects the southeast corner of the Okhla Bird Sanctuary to Noida Sector 168.
