Yogi Govt ensures availability of land for 1000 projects signed during GIS 2023

- Land being provided to investors in 73 districts of Uttar Pradesh for a variety of projects
- 16 Investors are informed about other land options as per the demand
- Land allotted to 2 investors before the ground breaking ceremony

Lucknow, May 21, 2023:

Having attracted investment of a whopping Rs 35 lakh crore to Uttar Pradesh through the Global Investors Summit 2023 (GIS 2023), the Yogi government is constantly making efforts to provide land to the investors for their projects. In this context, the government has already ensured availability of land for more than 1,000 projects for which it received requests from investors.

Notably, of more than 22000 investment deals signed at GIS, the government received land acquisition requests for more than 1,450 projects MoUs while it made land available for 1000. Meanwhile, efforts are being made to make land available for the remaining over 400 MoUs.

It is worth mentioning that after a successful conclusion of UPGIS 2023 in February this year, the state government held discussion with investors and instructed all the departments to ensure availability of land on the basis of MoU. Many departments including UPSIDA have already started work on land bank-like facilities.

Land allotment process completed for 2 MoUs

Even before the ground breaking ceremony, the Yogi government has completed the process of allotment of land to implement two MoUs on the ground. Besides, the government has suggested land options to 16 investors as per their demand. According to the government arrangement, options can be suggested through DM Login and by visiting the site.

Highest demand for land in Gautam Buddha Nagar and Ghaziabad

Areas of Western UP like Gautam Buddha Nagar and Ghaziabad are highly in demand for land. However, the state's capital Lucknow has been reported with the availability of maximum land.

Land was demanded for 72 MoUs in Lucknow, against which a maximum of 46 land availability has been ensured. Similarly, 42 out of 51 land has been made available in Aligarh, 42 out of 43 in Azamgarh, 40 out of 44 in Jaunpur, 36 out of 93 in Gautam Budh Nagar and 32 out of 44 in Meerut. Ghaziabad has the highest demand for 157 lands, presently out of which the availability of 18 has been ensured.

100% land availability in many districts

Apart from Lucknow, there are many districts where 100 percent land availability has been ensured as per the demand. Such districts include Fatehpur (19), Mau (10), Chandauli (12), Hamirpur (11), Mahoba (11), Ambedkarnagar (10), Farrukhabad (5), Shravasti (4), Siddharthnagar (4), Ballia (3), Kaushambi (2), Lakhimpur Kheri (2) and Pilibhit (1).

At present, Kannauj is the only one among all the 75 districts of the state, where there is zero demand for land. The DMs of all the districts have to provide information about the availability of land to the investors through Invest UP.
