'Work on Ganga e-way on schedule'

Lucknow: The state government has asked the companies entrusted with the construction of 594-km long Ganga Expressway to use green measures and technology as far as possible.

Work on the longest expressway in the country that will link Meerut to Prayagraj at a cost of Rs 17,000 crore is going as per the schedule.

Adani Group has been engaged for constructing

464-km long portion of the expressway from Badaun to Prayagraj in three packages. "The environment-friendly expressway will pass through 12 districts in the state. The six-lane carriageway can be expanded up to eight lanes in the future," said a company spokesperson.

Some measures to be taken during the construction, include using recycled material, natural restoration of slope, energy saving and pollution control measures among others.
