

# IIT-Kanpur, BHU Retain Last Year's Position

## Eight UP institutes find place in NIRF's top 100

**Lucknow:** Like last year, eight higher educational institutes located in Uttar Pradesh figured among the top 100 academic institutions of the country in the 'overall category' list of National Institutional Ranking Framework by Union ministry of education on Monday.

While IIT-Kanpur bagged the top slot in the 'Innovation', a new category included this year, it, along with BHU retained their last year's positions and clinched 5th and 11th ranks respectively in the overall category.

Being at the same rank, IIT-K's score dropped marginally, from 77.83 in 2022 to 77.23 in 2023. Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University which ranked 78th last year jumped to 69th this time. Its score improved by almost three points – from 46.39 in 2022 to 49.53 in 2023.

Slipping down by two positions, BHU's Indian Institute of Technology got 31st rank against 29th in 2022, while King George's Medical University went down to 77th place, from 75th in 2022.

Even though KGMU's score increased by 1.5 marks from 47 in 2022 to 48.5 in 2023, its rank slipped. Two private universities, Amity University (Noida) and Shiv Nadar University (Greater Noida), were at 57th and 95th rank, respectively. The Amity University showed a significant decline from last year when it was ranked 42nd among all institutions in the country.

Of six government supported institutions, only KGMU is funded by the UP government, while the rest are central institutes. Not a single undergraduate/postgraduate degree college from UP found a place in the college category. BHU and AMU, though, made it to the top in several categories.

**Lucknow:** Indian Institute of Management, Lucknow retained sixth position among the top management institutes. Its overall score fell marginally, from 74.55 in 2022 to 74.11 in 2023. Since the launch of NIRF in 2016, IIML maintained its

place at number 4 among the B-schools in the country for five consecutive years before it slipped to 7th position in 2021.

With an overall score of 74.11, IIML saw an increased gap with other major competitors. TNN
