

Udyami Mitras to act as bridge between govt, investors: Yogi

Hands Over Job Letters To 102 New Recruits

Lucknow: Terming Udyami Mitras as a bridge between the government and the investors, Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Saturday said their major role is to improve ease of doing business and ensure more investments in the state.

Addressing the batch of 102 newly trained recruits on Saturday, the CM said that if any of them was willing to apply for a government job, they would be given age relaxation and additional weightage during recruitment.

He not only issued appointment letters to Udyami Mitras but also issued incentive money of Rs 232 cro-
