Bareilly set to get ₹2.9K cr investments

Lucknow: Bareilly district is set to receive investments worth Rs 2,950 crore as at least 39 investors have applied to the Bareilly Development Authority for various projects. Out of these, 23 projects with the total investment of Rs 362 crore have been approved.

The proposals include plans for group housing societies, health services, hotels, petrol pumps, commercial complexes and conference halls.

BDA vice-chairman Jogendra Singh said that approvals for investments worth Rs 400 crore were being processed while 12 investors were yet to produce their plans.
