

Mathura to get new compressed bio gas plant

Lucknow: After Varanasi, a new compressed bio gas (CBG) plant is taking shape at Shri Mata Ji Goshala in Barsana, Mathura. Being started by the Adani group, the plant will produce about 42 metric tonnes of gas daily. The plant will be ready in a year. Adani Group plans to invest over Rs 225 crore on the Barsana biogas project.

This plant has been designed in such a way that after its completion, it will be counted among the largest agricultural waste-based plant in India. Adani Total Gas has established the first bio-

gas of the state at a cost of Rs 24 crore in Shahanshahpur of Varanasi. After the 'bhoomi poojan' for the compressed bio gas plant in Barsana, the construction work is continuing at a fast pace. About 42 metric tonnes of gas will be produced daily in this plant to be set up on 25 acres. The plant will be ready in a year.
