

Investment in UP was distant dream till 6 years ago: Yogi

Lays Foundation Of ₹1,200Cr Ethanol Plant In Gorakhpur

Gorakhpur: CM Yogi Adityanath said here on Saturday that six years ago, investment was difficult in UP because of a weak law and order. Investors were afraid of setting up industries and doing business in the state, but the situation has improved in the past six years, he added.

Laying the foundation of a Rs 1,200 crore ethanol, ENA and bottling plant at GIDA Sector 26, Sahjanwa, he said: "When entrepreneurs and traders were not secure, how would their capital have remained safe? Not only did investors stay away, but entrepreneurs and traders were also not ready to invest. In past six years, law and order has become a model for country and investors want to come here. Proposals of Rs 36 lakh crore investment made at Global Investors Summit in February are proof of this."
