

Land will be acquired from 33 revenue villages in Jhansi

It will be developed by the Bundelkhand Industrial Development Authority (BIDA) in Jhansi. In the first phase of the project, an industrial city will be established by acquiring land from 33 revenue villages in Jhansi. The price of this land is Rs 6,312 crore,” he said.

The government had made a budgetary provision of Rs 5,000 crore for setting up BIDA in 2022-23. In the current financial year, a provision of Rs 5,000 crore in the form of a loan has been made under the Chief Minister Industrial Area Expansion and New Industrial Area Promotion Scheme. Of the total land to be acquired, Khanna said, 8,000 acres will be gram sabha land.

“This historic decision will accelerate the multidimensional development of Bundelkhand. The area around Jhansi will be developed on a large scale. This in-

dustrial city is proposed on the Jhansi-Gwalior route, which will also be connected to major cities in the country through a National Highway. It will be well connected to other cities in the state through the Bundelkhand Expressway, passing through Jalaun district from National Highway 27,” Khanna added.

BIDA will include townships and lead to the overall development of the area and the generation of large scale employment on a large scale. “The general public will get employment opportunities while the region will be de-
