- Work on projects worth Rs 4.28 lakh crore initiated through Investors Summit 2018
- More than Rs 36 lakh crore investment proposals received at UPGIS 2023
- Potential for more than 1 crore employment avenues through UPGIS 2023

- Target to set-up E-office system by March 2024 across all collectorates, commissionerate, directorates, etc
- UP's amended Startup Policy 2022 offers on-ground support to startups through a network of 55 incubators in the state, apart from financial incentives
- More than 1200 startups registered on 'Start in UP' portal
- UP contributes nearly 45% to mobile manufacturing in India and 26% mobile manufacturers operational in the state

LUSH GREEN & ABUNDANT WITH POSSIBILITIES

- UP number 1 in production of milk, sugarcane, mangoes, and Indian gooseberries
- UP produces about 20% of India's total food grain
- Rs 2.20 lakh crore paid to sugarcane farmers
- Rs 1.05 lakh crore paid to farmers for procurement of 225 lakh metric tonnes of wheat and 345.59 lakh metric tonnes of paddy
- Uttar Pradesh Millets Restoration Programme operational for promotion of millets
- Under the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Beema Yojana, compensation worth Rs 4,228 crore paid to 49.77 lakh state farmers
- Creation of additional irrigation potential of more than 23 lakh hectare. Completed 20 projects including Ban Sagar, Arjun Sahayak and Saryu Canal. More than 44 lakh farmers have benefitted
- Organic farming operational over 85,710 hectares across 49 districts
- Nand Baba Dairy Mission launched at a cost of Rs 1000 crore



- Mukhyamantri Krishak Durghatna Kalyan Yojana provides assistance of up to Rs 5 lakh to the dependents of a farmer, who dies or becomes *divyang* due to an accident, and if their age at the time of the accident is between 18 years and 70 years

POWERING UP A REFORMED UTTAR PRADESH

- Under 'Power For All' scheme, free electricity connection to 1.58 crore households
- Smart Metering and modernisation of electricity network under the 'Revamped Distribution Sector Scheme'
- 736 new power sub-stations of 33/11 KW established and capacity augmented for 1,528 sub-stations
- 53,354 MW solar power plants established under the Saubhagya Yojana



- Power generation target of 22000 MW in next 5 years under Solar Energy Policy 2022
- For lighting of public roads, 21,197 solar streetlights set up
- Bundelkhand Expressway being developed as 'Solar Expressway'
- Through the 'Solar Rooftop Plant' Programme, projects of 290 MW capacity established
- 1 lakh farmers benefitted through private tubewell connections
- Compressed biogas plants, biocoal, biodiesel and bioethanol being promoted
- Compressed biogas plant established in Gorakhpur

HEALTH IS THE NEW FOCAL POINT OF DEVELOPMENT

- Under the 'One District One Medical College' scheme, 65 Medical Colleges operational and 22 Medical Colleges under construction
- AIIMS operational in Gorakhpur & Raebareilly



- Medical insurance coverage of Rs 5 lakh to more than 9 crore beneficiaries under Ayushman Bharat and Mukhyamantri Jan Arogya Yojana
- Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical University in Lucknow
- Sizeable budget of more than Rs 20,000 crore allocated to the medical sector in 2023-24, and health and Rs 2,837.39 crore has been allocated for medical education
- Medical Device Park, set to be built on an area of 350 acres in Gautam Buddha Nagar, will not only manufacture medical devices but also create employment opportunities on a large scale
- Mukhyamantri Arogya Mela is held regularly, making people aware of government's health schemes like Ayushman Bharat Yojana and Mukhyamantri Jan Arogya Yojana. So far, 12 crore people have received treatment through the Mela
- 250 Community Healthcare Centres (CHCs) are operational with 24-hour emergency service, free admission, medicine, and diagnostic services. 361 CHCs offering tele-radiology services
- 3,988 new MBBS seats in medical colleges being run by the state government, 1,747 new seats in PG, 7,000 new seats in nursing and 2,000 new seats in paramedical
- Health ATMs being established across all CHCs and PHCs
- Uttar Pradesh has become the first state in India to have launched a rating system for nursing and paramedical colleges, under 'Mission Niramaya'
- Paramedical Centres of Excellence in Jhansi and Kannauj districts.
- Developing 11 nursing colleges under the existing medical colleges in Ambedkarnagar, Azamgarh, Ayodhya, Badaun, Bahraich, Banda, Basti, Firozabad, Jalaun, Saharanpur, and Shahjahanpur on PPP mode
