Yogi said that Gorakhpur now has a modern cruise as a gift. Importantly, local workers contributed to the preparation of this cruise.

Yogi emphasized that as the city improves, tourism, development, and new employment opportunities will also increase.

"If we provide security and a good environment, people from outside will come here. Investment will occur in every sector, and the city, along with the state and country, will progress. Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision of a developed India by 2047 will come true, and prosperity will come into everyone's life," said Yogi while direct-

ing the Gorakhpur Development Authority (GDA) and the tourism department to enhance water sports activities.

CM said that in six years, Ramgarh Tal has been developed into a new tourist desti-

nation. "Roads and footpaths have been built around it, and the bright lights make people feel like they are not in Gorakhpur," the CM said.

Tourism minister Jaiveer Singh said that getting a cruise was a moment of pride

for Gorakhpur.

"The lake, which was once synonymous with dirt and neglect, now hosts cruise services," he said.

MP Ravi Kishan said that it is a historic moment for Ramgarh Tal to have cruise operations inspired by CM Yogi's vision.

The construction of Lake Queen Cruise cost more than Rs 12 crore. The cruise offers facilities like a five-star hotel, with vegetarian and non-vegetarian cuisine.

The three-story cruise covers an area of 2,700 square feet and includes three halls for 150 people each and a highly specialized cabin for 15 people. A waiting platform is also provided. A two-hour cruise ride can be enjoyed during one trip.
