126 tourism projects worth ₹3,800cr to be launched in Ayodhya next month

Lucknow: The ground breaking ceremony likely to be held in February will see at least 126 projects related to the hospitality sector in Ayodhya getting launched. Worth approximately Rs 3,800 crore, these projects are likely to include four mega hospitality projects including hotels and resorts.

The four largest investments in the district are all in the hospitality sector, said a government official, and together these projects will bring in an investment of Rs 420 crore. Giving a break-up of the four projects, the official said that with an investment of Rs 140 crore, Panache Dreamworld LLP is going to set up O Rama Hotels and Resorts. The Innovators Digital will invest Rs 100 crore in setting up the Solitaire Ayodhya,

a five-star hotel. Evergreen Infra India Pvt Ltd will invest Rs 90 crore for Shri Ramya Hotel while Samriddhi Swastik Trading and Investment Ltd will set up a Vishranti Griha at an investment of Rs 86 crore.

"There are around 126 tourism sector projects for Ayodhya which are set to be implemented during the upcoming ground breaking ceremony.

Out of these, 46 are those for which MoUS have been signed. These are worth Rs 1,923.34 crore while the remaining 80 are those for which proposals came to the government after the Global Investors Summit of February 2023 and these are worth Rs 1,854 crore," the official said.
