

6 devpt bodies ready with ₹3L cr projects

Set For Launch At Ground Breaking Meet

Lucknow. Six industrial development authorities in Uttar Pradesh are ready to launch investment projects worth Rs 3.10 lakh crore at the upcoming Ground Breaking Ceremony (GBC) in the state. Their investments would amount to about 40% of the total worth of projects expected to be launched at the GBC.

A government spokesman said the date for the GBC would be announced soon. He said while the Yamuna Expressway Indust-

rial Development Authority (YEIDA) has achieved more than 100% of the target set for GBC, other authorities are also actively working towards reaching their set targets.

“Under the leadership of Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath, YEIDA, GNIDA, Noida, GIDA, UPSIDA,

UPEIDA had collectively signed agreements for more than 5,500 projects worth around Rs 9.25 lakh crore through MOUs and non-MOUs.

Through these agreements, the government has set a target to bring an investment of Rs 4.25 lakh crore to the ground for

GBC,” the spokesperson said.

Officials said YEIDA was given a target of Rs 43,750 crore for GBC but it has secured 414 MoUs and non-MoU projects worth more than Rs 2 lakh crore. Out of these, it has prepared 280 projects for GBC, with total cost exceeding Rs 45,000 crore. This means YEIDA has achieved 103% of its target, making it ready for immediate implementation through GBC.

In terms of percentage achievement of the target, the Greater Noida Industrial Development Authority (GNIDA) stands second. It had signed agreements for 244 projects with total cost of Rs 1.10 lakh crore through MOUs and non-MOUs. For GBC, it had a target of

launching an investment of Rs 60,000 crore, against which 150 projects have already received the green signal. Its total cost is more than Rs 52,000 crore, which is 87% of the target.

Noida Industrial Development Authority (NOIDA) had signed MOUs and non-MOUs for 544 projects exceeding Rs 1.10 lakh crore. It had a GBC target of Rs 90,000 crore, of which it has achieved 73% target, that is, more than Rs 65,000 crore. Through this, 150 projects are ready for GBC.

Similarly, the Gorakhpur Industrial Development Authority (GIDA) has met 68% of the target. It had signed MOUs and non-MOUs for 324 projects valued at Rs 21,000 crore. With GBC target of Rs 12,500 crore, GI-

DA has successfully readied 279 projects worth Rs 8,500 crore for GBC.

Uttar Pradesh State Industrial Development Authority (UPSIDA) has achieved 67% of its target. Having signed agreements for 3,800 projects valued at more than Rs 4 lakh crore, UPSIDA has met a target of Rs 2 lakh crore. It has made preparations to launch more than 3,400 projects worth more than Rs 1.3 lakh crore.

Uttar Pradesh Expressway Industrial Development Authority (UPEIDA) had signed agreements for 123 projects, costing over Rs 80,000 crore, with GBC target exceeding Rs 18,000 crore. It has successfully prepared 35 projects for GBC, totaling around Rs 5,000 crore.
