Group bagged the rights to develop UP government's ambitious Film City near the upcoming Noida International Airport, for which chief minister Yogi Adityanath

had himself met industry representatives in Mumbai.

There were three other players in the fray – T-Series and two consortiums backed by actor Akshay Kumar (Su-

per Technobuild) and producer KC Bokadia (4 Lions Films). But Bayview turned out to be the winner with an 18% revenue sharing offer to

the state government. While 4 Lions offered 15.1%, Supersonic quoted 10.8% and T-Series 5.3%.

With a moratorium period of eight years, the developer

will start paying the Yamuna Expressway Authority 18% of its gross revenue from the ninth year.
