The company proposed to do Capacity building with Microsoft certification on Data management to optimise and enhance productivity.

Earlier, a day before, the Uttar Pradesh Government approved a new policy for the semiconductor industry, offering rebates, concessions, and subsidies to companies establishing their units in the state.
