

NTT Data launches new data centre campus in Noida, UP

NTT, the global IT infrastructure and services company has launched its new data centre campus in Noida, Uttar Pradesh. Spanning six acres, the campus, named Noida 2 will support a planned capacity of 52.8 MW critical IT load in two data centres. The first data centre within the campus will support 22.4 MW IT load with an area of 3,00,000 sq. ft.

The campus is located in Noida's data centre corridor within the Delhi-NCR region. It is carrier-neutral and interconnected with NTT's other data centre locations for minimal latency, which will enable seamless access to top-tier public cloud providers. Advanced features include high levels of automation to monitor and optimise facility performance as well as resources like power and water.

Moreover, this is the first data centre campus in India to incorporate seismic dampers, which will ensure uninterrupted operations.
