Tourism dept flooded with queries on Ayodhya and Varanasi trips

Lucknow: UP Tourism office is abuzz with queries on Ayodhya and Varanasi these days. While phones keep ringing on the department's information lines, stalls of UP Tourism set up at official events are getting an overwhelming response.

On the kind of queries, Ashwani said: "Most of the callers ask about the best route to reach Ayodhya from Varanasi and vice-versa... They also enquire about road transport buses and hotels availability. Some queries pertain to what more can be explored while visiting these

two places." He added that scores of tour operators are asking the tourism department to suggest possible itineraries so that they can focus on implementation and logistics.

Organised by the Holiday Expo Travel and Exhibition in Coimbatore, in association with the tourism departments of Uttar Pradesh, Delhi, Jharkhand, and Tamil Nadu, the expo has provided an opportunity to various players to promote their products.
